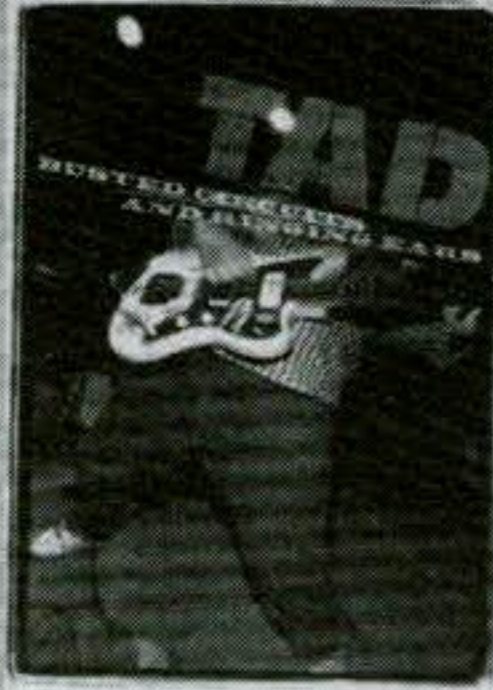

Footage of live shows and personal behind-the-scenes stuff is interspersed with interviews with luminaries including producer Jack Endino, Mark Arm of Mudhoney, Kim Thayil of Soundgarden, Krist Novoselic of Nirvana, Jonathan Poneman and Bruce Pavitt of Sub-Pop Records, Marky Felchtone of Zeke, author of Kurt Cobain bio *Heavier Than Heaven*

Charles Cross, comic artist Peter Bagge of Hate, photojournalist Charles Peterson, manager Jon Zazula and band members Kurt Danielson, Steve Weid, Chad Channing, Josh Sinder and Gary Thorstensen. The DVD relates the rise and fall of not only the Seattle scene but of TAD the band itself, a cautionary tale that is honest and completely fascinating.
