El Duce and company assaulted the hard rock/metal community for several years with their own brand of sadistic rock n' roll until El Duce's "untimely death". Not to be taken too seriously, The Mentors wrote perverse songs full of tongue-in-cheek lyrics that would make your blushing mom kick you out of the house. The Mentors songs are composed purely on sex and booze. *El Duce Vita* marks the first commercial DVD release of the band. The first part of the disc begins with the infamous *The Wretched World of the Mentors*, which is a 30 minute compilation of x-rated, sometimes grotesque videos that the band made themselves. Featured videos are *On the Rag, Forty Ouncer, Golden Showers, Donkey Dick, When You're Horny, You're Horny, All Women are Insane* and *Sex Slave*. The quality of the film is unsurprisingly poor since these were hand made, the results being amateurish at best. Also included are some live performances of the band before El Duce's untimely demise. If you were ever a fan of The Mentors, then this is for you. If you're looking for a good laugh and aren't offended easily, then this is for also you.
