'Tim Buckley: My Fleeting House'



XL Recommended - 'Tim Buckley: My Fleeting House' : Tim Buckley still exerts a magical influence among the young and hip. His music went from Dylanish folk to a pan-genre mix that seemed beamed in from rural Venus. He died of a heroin overdose in 1975 at the age of 28, thus solidifying his mythic status. And then there's the son Jeff, with whom he had a distant if not nearly nonexistent relationship, who also cut some records and died young. So there's a lot of lore floating around the guy and his music. 'Tim Buckley: My Fleeting House' collects the rare, stray television performances, including 13 full-length songs. DVDs of the film will be available after the show. The Lovely Sparrows also perform.
