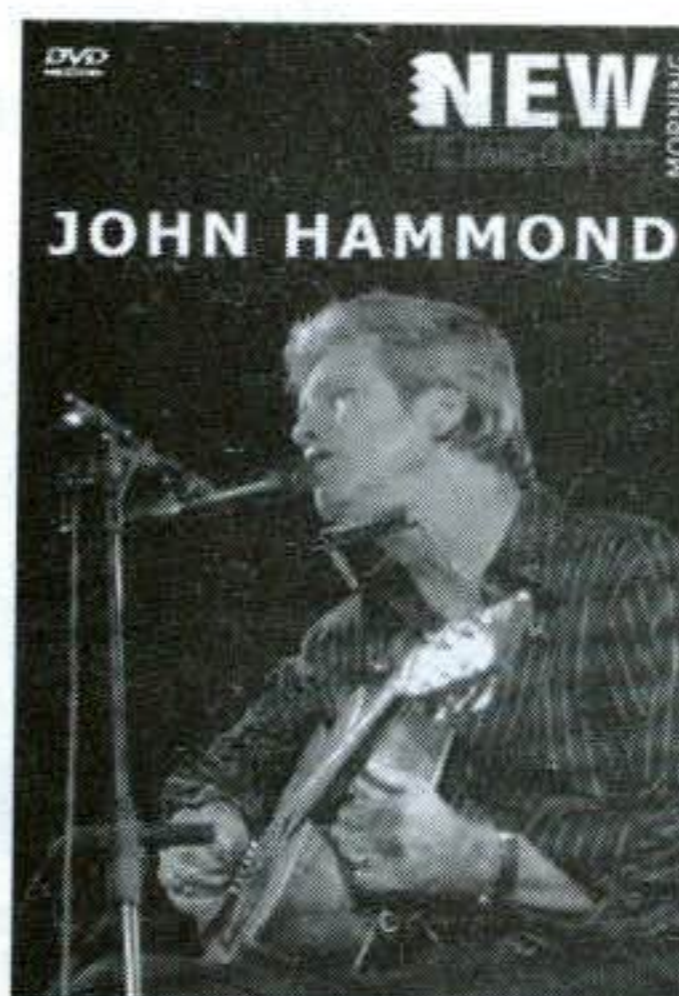


RORY GALLAGHER

(MVD)

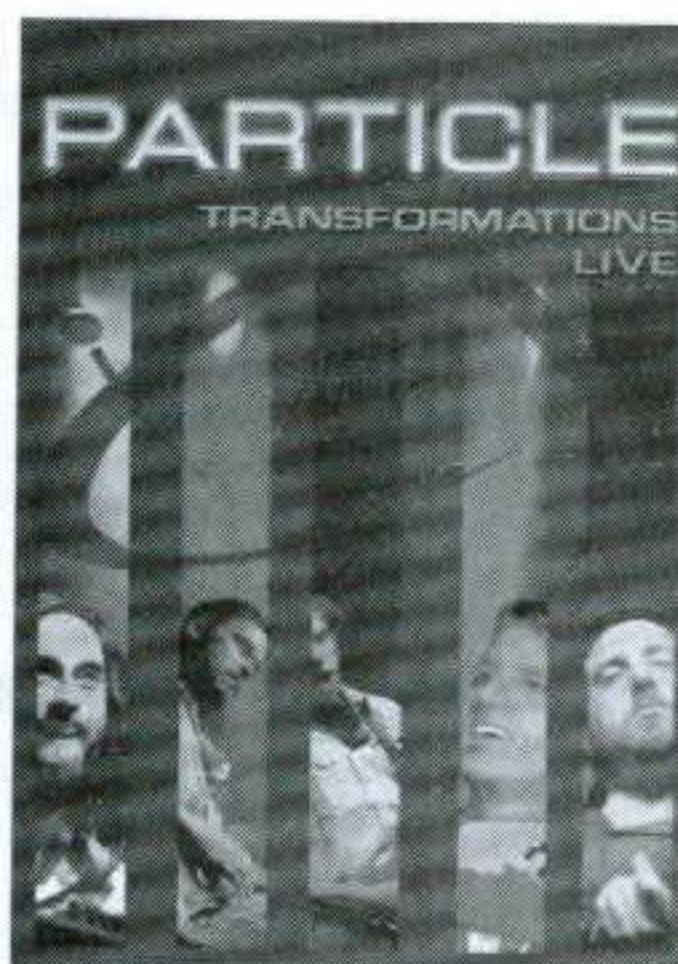

(MVD)

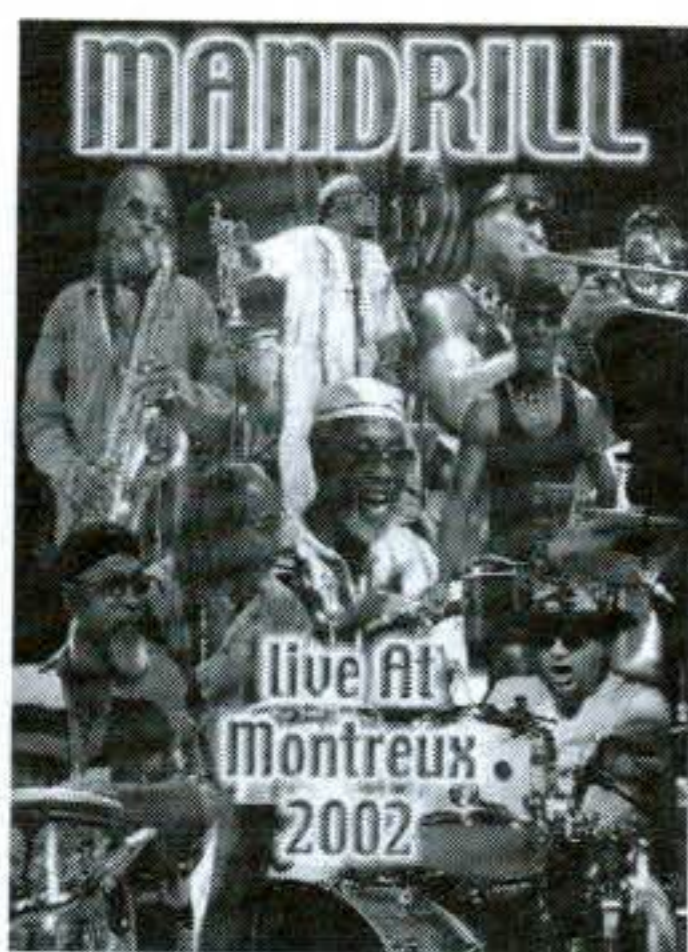

For six years, Particle has dominated as one of the world's preeminent techno-drenched jam bands. Having replaced their founding guitarist with two very impressive guitarists, Particle has redefined and expanded their sound by also adding vocals to the mix. Highlights of the live set include: "Lucky Man" and "W" (with Joe Satriani and DJ Logic).



MANDRILL

LIVE AT MONTREUX
(WILSON BROS.)

As a companion piece to the live CD of the same show, Mandrill demonstrates their infectious live energy of soul-drenched passion with their performance at the Montreux Jazz Festival. The tight horn arrangements and uplifting delivery on tracks such as "Hang Loose" and "Peace and Love" will delight fans of impressive rhythmic interaction.



LEE "SCRATCH" PERRY

THE ULTIMATE ALIEN
(MVD)

Originally performed at Concorde 2 in Brighton, UK on February 19, 2002, the nine-song set includes Perry's "Tighten Up," "Jungle Lion," and "I Am a Madman." The bonus features actually rival the performance because the rehearsal footage and interview include the famed producer/performer discussing his work with Bob Marley and his lifelong experiences in the music business.
