## Ninetail - Half Truths and Hand Grenades



**Ninetail** is a six piece from Pennsylvania and *Half Truths and Hand Grenades* is their latest release. The band formed back in 1999, but only survived approx. 3 years before calling it quits. Fast forward approx. 3 years to 2005, and the band reformed with the goal to spread their raw brand of heavy metal around the globe. Ninetail is a raw metal band in the form of **Fear Factory**, **Skinlab** and **Chimara**. The music isn't real melodic or catchy, it is just raw. Not sure how to really describe it other than than.

Half Truths and Hand Grenades is one of those albums you'll either love or hate. It is just pure aggressive metal that will either make you bang your head or reach for the eject button.
