❑ **JACK THE RIPPER (IMAGE, 1976):** Jess Franco's take on the Whitechapel legend, with Klaus Kinski in the title role, on DVD uncut with commentary by producer Erwin C. Dietrich, a deleted scene and two featurettes.

❑ **JESUS CHRIST: VAMPIRE HUNTER (ELECTRIC/MUSIC VIDEO, 2002):** He teams with a Mexican wrestler to fight evil. Oh yeah, and it's a musical. What more do you need? The DVD has filmmaker commentary, interviews, outtakes and other extras.

❑ **KILLER RATS (VELOCITY, 2003):** Rodents rampage through a hospital for the rich, addicted and/or insane in the latest (and prob-

ably last) of Nu Image's nature-amok series. Directed by Tibor (The Gate) Takacs, starring Ron Perlman.

❑ **MANIACAL (CINEMA-CABRE, 2003):** Director/FXer Joe Castro's latest follows the bloody trail of nuthouse escapee Gilbert Gill. The DVD comes with behind-the-scenes footage, interviews, etc.

❑ **MUMMY'S KISS (SE-DUCTION CINEMA/E.I., 2003):** An ancient Egyptian princess is reborn in modern LA and terrorizes Richard Lynch et al. The DVD has commentary by director Don Glut, bloopers and a making-of featurette.

❑ **PYTHON 2 (FOX, 2003):** Wartorn Chechnya becomes a constricted area when a scaly American "weapon" is accidentally unleashed there. Billy Zabka returns from the original.
