"Jesus Christ Vampire Hunter"

Let's face it. This will offend pretty much everybody. But while I do think the filmmakers are maybe a bit too harsh in their broad, low-brow satire, I'd be lying through my teeth if I said this wasn't funny. And for a low-budget, way underground piece like this, the action scenes are, if amateur, fairly well done. The basic premise is that Jesus teams up with a professional wrestler to battle vampires.

You've got a punk rock priest, a kung fu battle on the beach, a musical number and another kung-fu fight, this time between Jesus and an absurdly full jeep (think clowns piling out of a car) of atheists. And that's before you even meet the wrestler. So. In some ways you're in South Park territory here (though this actually seems less mean-spirited) in that you want to laugh and be offended at the same time. Whatever you do, don't take it seriously. — Kristofer Upiohn, **B-**
