

Buy Lovedolls Superstar on DVD

David Markey made the greatest Super-8 film of the 1980s with *Desperate Teenage* Lovedolls, produced for about \$250. Two years later, he made this sequel for \$10,000, and in many ways it's a far superior, far more watchable film. Now Markey has given us his "fully realized" version, which was transferred directly from the film elements to a new DVD and mastered with fresh, new audio. The great soundtrack really sparkles now, and tunes from Redd Kross, the Meat Puppets, Sonic Youth and the Dead Kennedys virtually explode from your speakers. The members of the Lovedolls (who split up in the previous film) reunite: Kitty Karry-All (Jennifer Schwartz) has become a wino and Patch Kelly (Janet Housden) has become the

"spaceship" for an intergalactic tour. Lovedolls Superstar has more in the way of enthusiasm and
