

DOGS O'WAR COLLECTION: WWII - The European Front 10 Film Set

This is the first in a multi-part series of WWII motion picture dramas starting with the European Front. From the deserts of North Africa to the blitzkrieg of London, the Dogs O' War Collection covers all the major war action like none other. The collection contains ten World War II classics.

Roosevelt, Churchill, and Stalin are targeted for death, in "Desert Commando" (1967). A hidden fortune is fought over by Nazis and Allied prisoners, in "Dirty Heroes" (1969). A British officer chases German saboteurs, in "Eagles Over London" (1969). An American major is stranded behind enemy lines, but he and his "Hellcommandoes" (1969) still have a mission to complete. A pair of G.I.s link up with a Yugoslavian resistance group to harass the Germans, in "Operation: Cross Eagles" (1969). Can a German soldier and an American make peace long enough to survive the dangers of the North African

desert, or will the "War Devils" (1969) perish in the attempt? A British officer tries to teach "Heroes Without Glory" (1971) the proper way to win a war. A young Greek woman working for the Resistance must seduce a Nazi officer in order to steal vital war plans, in "Mediterranean in Flames" (1972). A small band of escaped Allied POWs receives a suicide mission: to cross "The Bridge to Hell" (1986). "War Boy" (1987) observes the horrors of conflict through a small boy's eyes.

As time passes, each reveals to the group for the first time what he has lost in the interim. Some have abused drugs or drink; others have profited from unethical money deals; and one has even had sex with one of the other men's wives.



THE BASKET

When Martin Conlon arrives in a small town in the Pacific Northwest as America is reeling from World War I, he brings with him a message of love and teamwork. He uses his position as a schoolteacher to introduce the game of basketball to the community. After a group of German refugees settle in the town, tensions mount. Conlon uses an approaching basketball game to teach the town a lesson about understanding.

THE LAST LETTER

Jack Hamilton has been on trial for the brutal murders of fourteen people. When the judge turns the case over to the jury for deliberations, eleven jurors are convinced Hamilton is guilty. The jury foreman is sure that an innocent man has been accused of crimes he didn't commit. He begins to punch holes in the prosecution's case, and votes are swayed. In this jury room nothing is what it seems.

APOCALYPTO

DEJA VU
