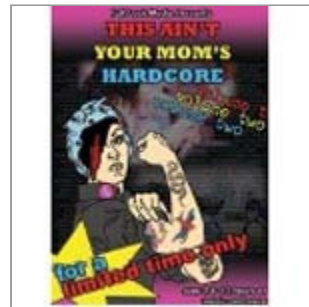

This Ain't Your Mom's Hardcore Vol. 2

Dirty, scrappy little hardcore DVD with all the sweat, energy and passion you'd expect from the underground...and, no you won't have to hide it from your parents.



Packed with camera angles that defy the injuries the cameraman SURELY braved, the kind of hardcore that raises hairs on necks and the kind of fierce devotion no other genre of music gets from their fans, this is quality through and through.

Sure, as you might expect, production values are as DIY as the bands, but wrapped up in the kind of rough and ready love that embraces hardcore to its core I may not have heard of any of these bands - showing my age and the fact that, musically, I've most definitely moved on - but this doesn't stop me wiping away a tear at those lost days of mosh pit heaven and frantically yelled words of confidence and political ire.

Much unneeded are the snippets of interviews that show slightly embarrassed bands going through the motions, mucking about and not really offering anything interesting or new. That's fine, it could well be the questions asked (and so often is), but why are they there? Perhaps as punctuation points - breathing gaps - between the full on metallic assault of the live performances.

It's only fair to say that this is for fans only, and people who want a nostalgia kick. Or, kids who are interested in figuring out where to direct their anger positively - I really do think getting kids into hardcore is a way to prevent the potential of them turning to street crime or violence. To a lot of other people, it will seem so atrocious as to be laughable. To me it's hard to doubt the sincerity in some of the music. Some, not all. There's some proper poser material here too.
