



K, this is NOT male propaganda, but a genuine scientific study that suggests sex will help keep your mind sharp as you age!

Research published in the American Journal of Geriatric Psychiatry showed that study participants ranging in age from 58 to 98 did better on memory and abstract thinking tests if they reported being satisfied with their sex lives.

And the link was especially strong in women.

Previous research credited sexual intercourse with the growth of new brain cells in mice, which humans can apparently accomplish by doing something as simple as crossword puzzles.

Meanwhile, the researchers emphasize that sex is not only for the young, saying, "The reality of aging is that most people continue to have sexual feelings."
