The DVD that comes with it is in fact not much different. With 97-minute DVD and two follow pressed CDs, the box properly pumped. It's funny to see how time bands like Pink Floyd and Dr.. John and inexperienced rookies were on stage, thinking a great show to put down. We now know better and know that they really can. At that time they were probably the only ones that thought. 'The Dutch Woodstock' is a box that is made for the enthusiast. The lover of the respective bands, visitors to the festival and just lovers of a piece of music.
