

Tribute to Adam

A TRIBUTE album to rock icon Adam Goren will raise money for a diabetic charity.

Up End Atom: A Tribute To Atom And His Package (Hartless Hind Records) sees a number of rock bands perform the songs of Adam.

Born in the Bronx in 1975, Adam was the sole member of Atom and His Package.

He grew up in Oreland, Pennsylvania and played in several local bands.

In 1997 he released his first album, The First CD. He released several more albums and EPs.

In April 2003, Adam was diagnosed with type one diabetes, which led to his decision to stop touring as Atom and His Package. He performed his final show on August 29, 2003 in Philadelphia. A DVD of the show was included with his last album Hair: Debatable.

Last November 1, Adam resurrected the name for a gig in Florida.

He currently plays with the band Armalite and teaches at a school in Philadelphia.

Among the group's on Up End Atom are Aussie punk Yidcore and The Zambonis.
