J.D. Malone and the Experts

This local band formed in 2009 and has just released its first album. *Avalon* follows in the line of sounds by American rock bands such as Creedence and Tom Petty and the Heartbreakers (the only two nonoriginals on the two-disc CD/DVD set are by those bands), while also incorporating the kind of twang and harmonizing you might hear from the Everly Brothers or Foster & Lloyd. But it never sounds derivative. Front man J.D. Malone, formerly of Steamroller Picnic and a fixture on the Philly music scene, writes songs that grab you right away and then resonate deeply. The four Experts behind the singer-guitarist enhance the freshness and vitality with tight ensemble playing that also projects a live immediacy. In other words, a pretty impressive debut.
