

All that Jazz - This month brought two jazz items. First, from the sometimes interesting Idem DVD label (distributed in the U.S. by MVD) comes Billie Holiday: The Life and Artistry of Lady Day, which contains an uncredited - and undated - 27-minute documentary on the singer with lots of footage from her feature film debut, New Orleans, the Ellington short Symphony in Black, and the TV show The Sound of Jazz mixed with many stills. The scenes from New Orleans are repeated as bonus features. There's nothing new here and, with its low budget quality, I can't recommend it.
