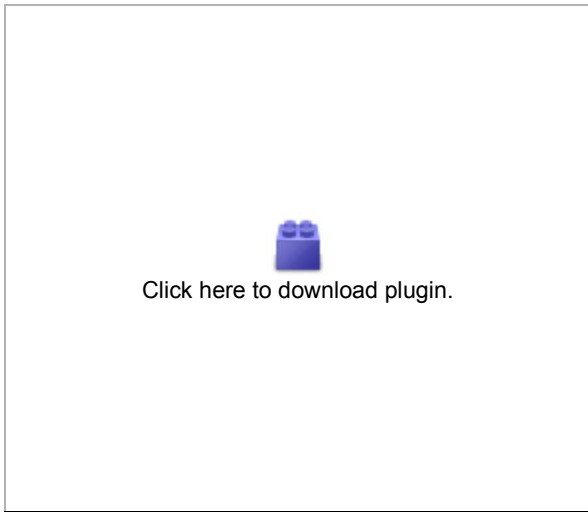

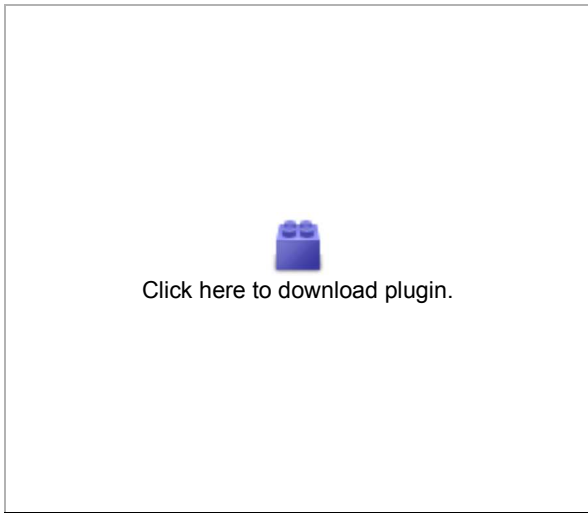

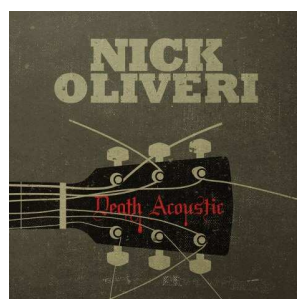

CD Review: Nick Oliveri

What do you get when you mix passion, anger and a raw acoustic sound? You get Nick Oliveri's latest venture, *Death Acoustic*. The album delves into the mind of one of rock's most intriguing figures. Having spent time with some of the most innovative bands to come out of this century such as the stoner rock band Kyuss, the

unpredictable The Dwarves and the uniquely influential Queens Of The Stone Age, whom Nick laid down some of his best work with and contributed greatly to the shape and sound. *Death Acoustic* is not your typical acoustic record. The record has sharp jabs of playful words that sometimes verge on deranged reality, beautifully blended in with high-powered acoustic strumming over a musical landscape that is dissonant as well as catchy, trippy and definitely out of the box. If you were expecting Nick to sing about love, relationships and broken hearts over a slowed down, kumbaya type pace, then you're about to get your mind blown into pieces. Yes there are joyous happy moments, actually there's a lot, but the bittersweet moments are where Nick shines the most and with lyrics like "I don't care where you're going, just as long as you're following me, come be free" and "I can sing all these song about bitches, I still fuck all the prostitutes I know, they tell me I smell like a meth lab," you know this acoustic record is something different and special. Some of the tracks you need to play loud are "Dairy Queen," "Love Has Passed Me By," "U Blow," "Hybrid Moments," and "Follow Me." To get the whole experience of the record and feel the essence, skip to the last song and press play. "Outlaw Scumfuc" will play and you will either go get drunk, hire a prostitute, get in a fight or do all without any recollection or remorse the next day. The Queens Of The Stone Age cover of "I'm Gonna Leave You" sounds pristine and Nick sounds most comfortable and best on that track. Overall, *Death Acoustic* is a great acoustic record that defies the norm and speaks in volumes. The musicianship and arrangements do sound like they were thrown together fairly fast but the passion, the talent and the fire of Nick's voice and performance on the record is priceless. The ambience that the album illuminates also help give the album that personified, personalized feel that only true musicians can pull off on such a raw record. Nick is triumphant on this record. It's probably one of the best pieces of work that he's come up with in a while that spells out Nick Oliveri. So get yours, plug in the headphones and get high off the music. It's going to feel good, trust me.
