Review: Lately I receive some material containing real basic old school stuff. Is it stoner? Maybe, maybe not, because some songs are really fast like the opening song '9 volt' on this album. This is heavy shit! 'Crazy For You' contains some reggae-sky influences to explode in real heavy stuff.

Eleven songs of a decent level pass by. The dish sounds really wel. Production is OK and everything is in perfect balance. 'Our Career' sounds a bit like the old Motörhead. You have to take a listen to 'Goodbye'. The guitare intro just sounds the same as Chuck Berry's 'Johnny B Good'. I rather think this is done on purpose to pay a tribute to the man.

Conclusion: Good record, not original, but worth a listen to buy.
