Bug Girl Dirt In The Skirt

10 Track, **LP** (2010, Impedance Records) Related: Bug Girl.

Thank fuck for filthy party rock'n'roll! Australians are so good at making it and there's nothing better than chucking on a platter like this to wipe away all the hipster posturing, navel gazing experimental pretentiousness and twee Hello Kitty pop and rediscover the simple joys of cars, chicks and greasy jeans.

Bug Girl are a duo fronted by Amber Spence on guitar and vocals and her brother Clinton on drums. They live and breathe rock'n'roll. Bug Girl seemingly exist outside the boundaries of contemporary popular culture and they genuinely don't give a fuck. On *Dirt In The Skirt* they show just what can happen if you grow up on a steady diet of Mötley Crüe, The Runaways, AC/DC, Guns N' Roses and other greats of the genre.

Bug Girl have absorbed these influences and turned them into 10 red-hot slabs of squealing, metallic rock that sound best blasting from a car stereo cruising around the suburbs on a Saturday night. The lyrics are pure cliche, but like Girlschool or The Runaways, a line like "spread me like butter, spill me like wine" ('Spread That Eagle') sounds incredibly cool being delivered by a sassy woman, especially when she backs it up with some hot guitar licks that could make Lita Ford blush. The guitar sound is so full and upfront that the absence of bass is hardly noticeable. There are no ballads, just one short, sharp blast after another, the way a great rock album should be. For two people, Bug Girl create one hell of a racket.

How a record like this fits into the overall picture of Australian rock in 2010 is anybody's guess. It's best to turn off one's critical faculties and enjoy *Dirt In The Skirt* for what it is – a celebration of big, dumb fun with furiously loud guitars, walloping drums and lots of wailing vocals. Bug Girl's music is beyond current notions of "cool", or "cutting edge". Instead, it distills the spirit of a vanishing outer suburban rev-head culture and imbues it with just enough knowing self-mockery to appeal to those for whom this world is as foreign and distant as the moon.

Underneath the devil-may-care bluster and party vibe, this album is a strangely nostalgic experience for those who grew up in suburban Australia over the past 30 years. While bored, disenfranchised teenagers in hotted-up cars still roam the streets of new estates on our urban fringes, the soundtrack that Bug Girl associate with this diversion is one that belongs to an already mythical past. Like the sharpies of the 1970s, true bogans are dying out, subsumed by new cultures. The soundtrack to a Saturday night cruising is more likely to consist of R&B or ethnic dance music than AC/DC these days.

But, hey, this doesn't detract from this being one hell of a record. Ultimately, *Dirt In The Skirt* is nothing but a good time.
