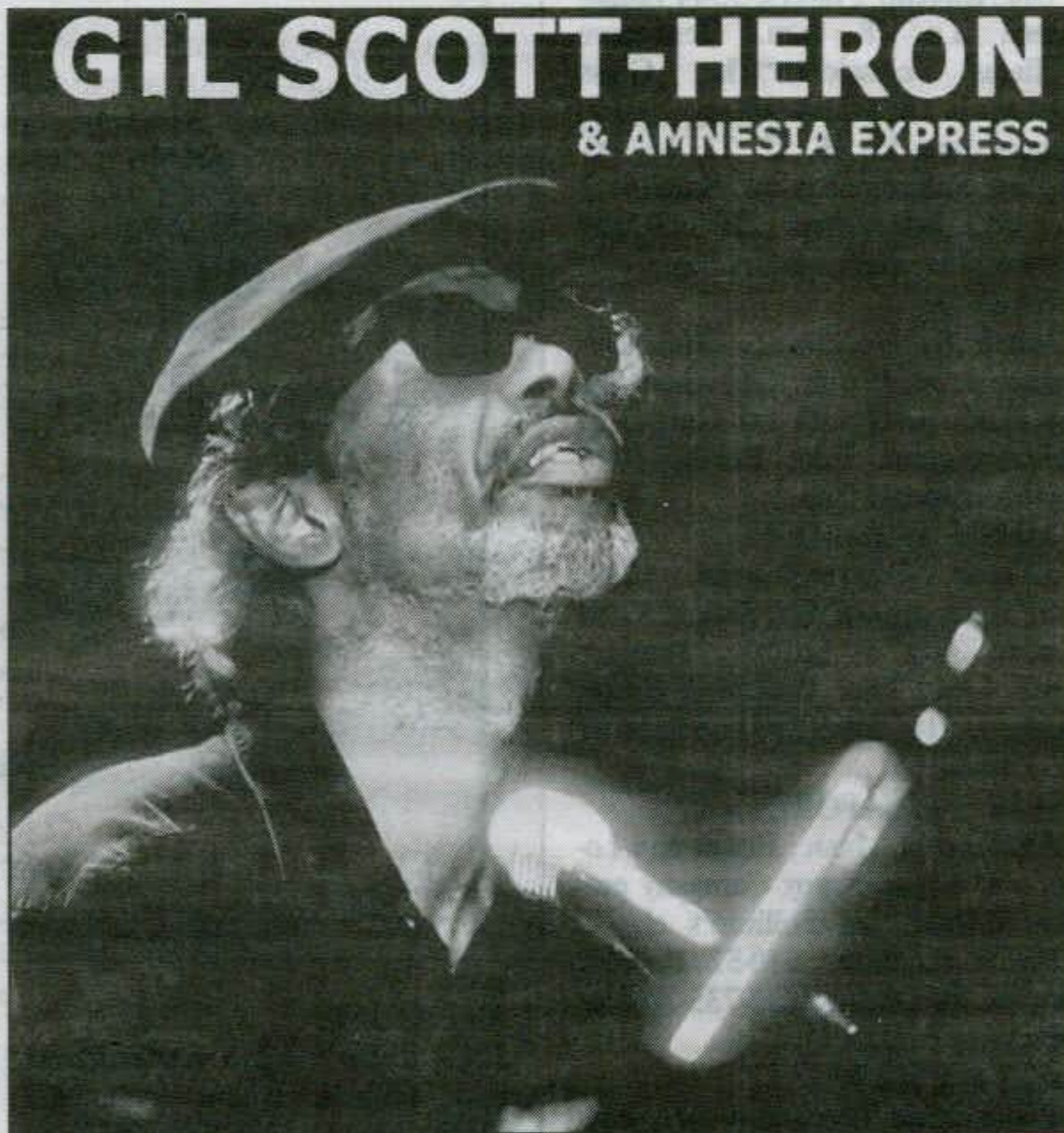
**Reelblack 'Soul Food Cinema' film series**

Reelblack returns to the Point of Destination Café, Greene and Upsal streets, for a special summer series of Soul Food Cinema. It's five programs focusing on "lost" blaxploitation and classic music from now until September, all for the cost of a soul food meal.

On Friday June 15, Reelblack will celebrate the DVD release of "Gil Scott-Heron: Live in Paris" (2001) with a special screening. This full-length performance at the New Morning in Paris showcases one of the greatest singers in the soul tradition, Gil Scott-Heron.

Inspired by writer Langston Hughes, one of the driving forces behind the Afro-centrism of the 60s, Scott-Heron put his first texts to music. He tried his hand at the keyboard in rock groups and published "The Nigger Factory." His music and lyrics, part poetic, part political, which denounce repressive violence exerted on African Americans by society, soon made him a cult hero of radical rap and hip-hop musicians throughout the world.

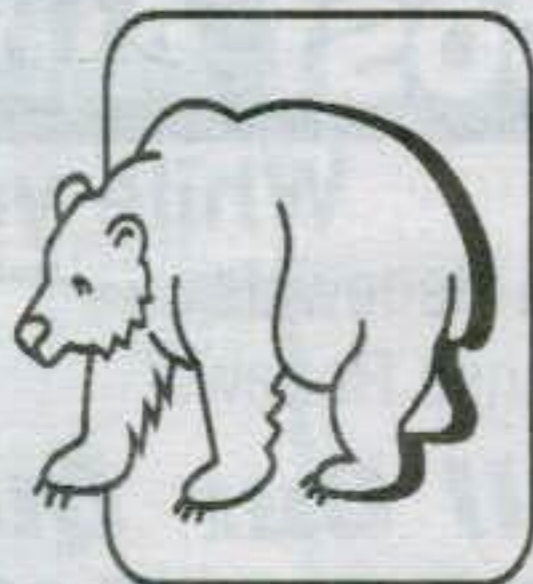
