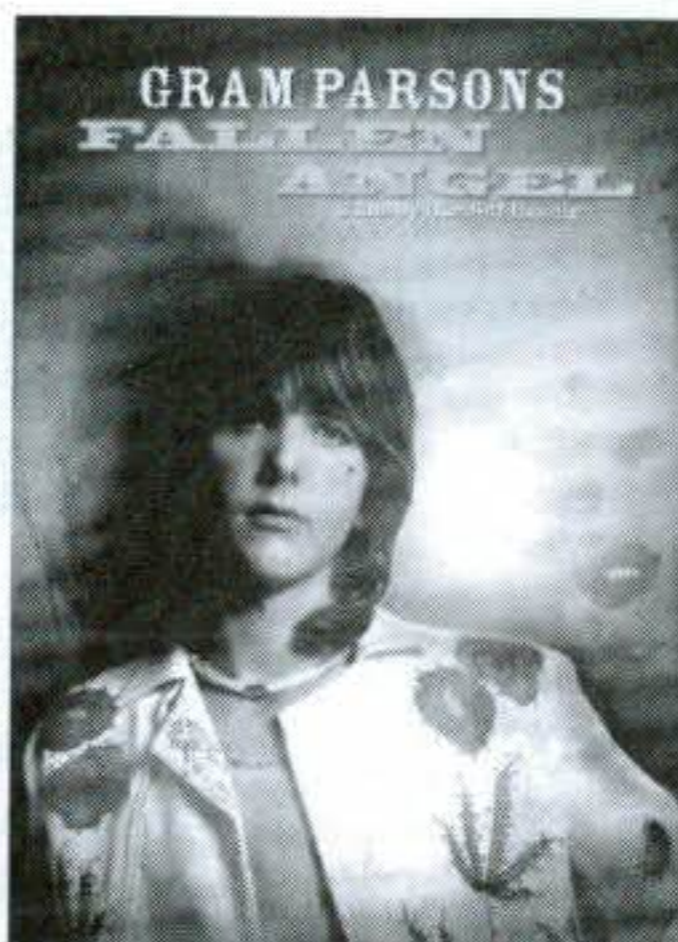




PAT METHENY GROUP

(EAGLE)

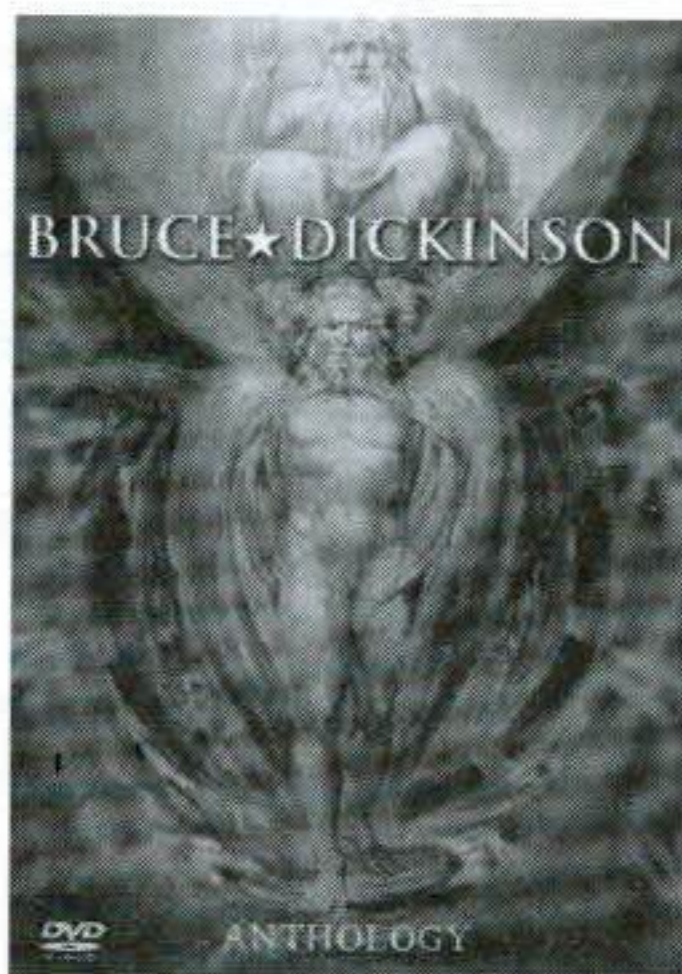

(RHINO)

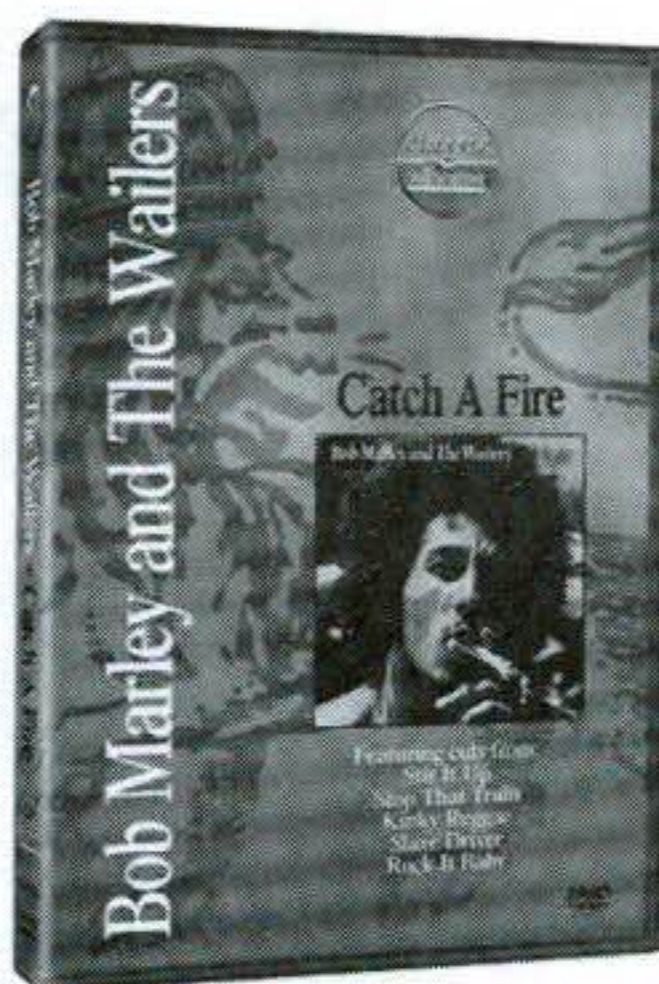

(SANCTUARY)

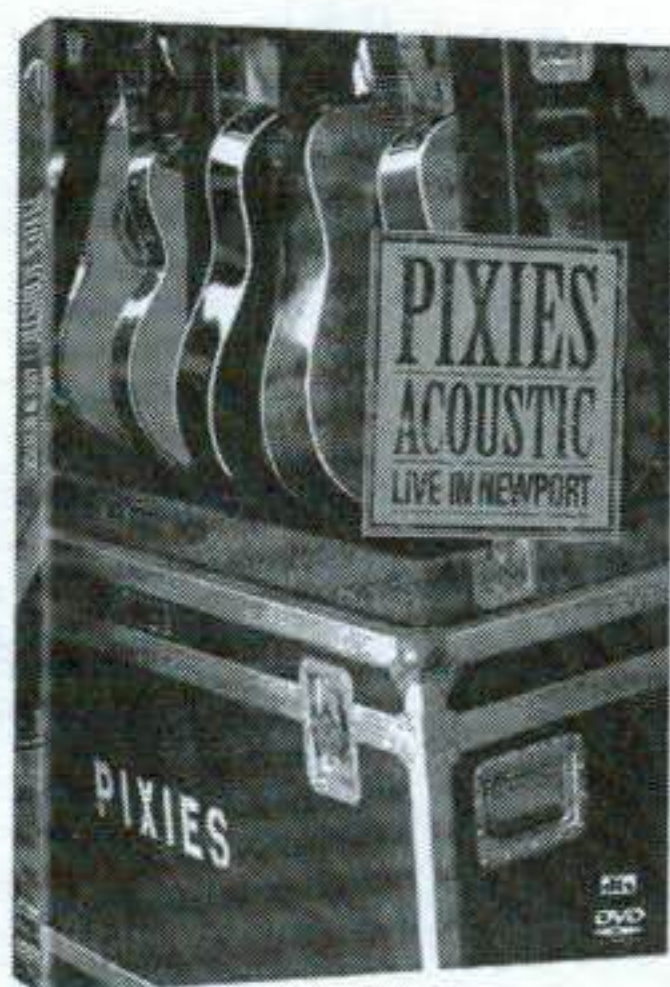
