by Ti West, these American horror films are packaged as one, 3-Disc Collector's Edition Box Set of X Trilogy: X, Pearl, and MaXXXine available in Blu-ray and 4K UHD formats, marking the first physical release of X and Pearl on 4K UHD in the US. The box set includes a 64-page booklet with a new essay by Jon Dieringer, unreleased concept art, costume sketches, behindthe-scenes photography, original poster and VHS artwork created as set dressing for the films, and more, alongside over 90 minutes of making-of featurettes and new commentary tracks on all three films. 7 SINS is a searing, subversive horror anthology that reimagines the seven deadly sins through seven twisted visions from some of underground cinema's boldest voices. Each segment explores a sin not by doctrine, but through raw, human impulse creating a portrait of desire, despair, and decay. The nightmare begins with WRATH, where a jogger's barely contained rage explodes in Dario Almerighi's harrowing opener. Sam Mason-Bell's haunting ENVY follows a couple lured into a tragic erotic encounter, while SLOTH, from Francesco Foletto and Elisa Carrera Fumagalli, spirals into self-harm. Michael J. Epstein's PRIDE tackles religious repression and fractured identity, and LUST, by Domiziano Cristopharo, explores a dis-turbing AI relationship. Jason Impev's GLUTTONY riffs on grindhouse cannibal flicks, and Poison Rouge's GREED closes the anthology with a harrow-ing tale of sex work, debt, and damnation. Dripping in gore, laced with nudity, and steeped in sorrow, 7 SINS is more than shock for shock's sake — it's a meditation on why we fall. SPINAL TAP II – THE END

Saint Agnellus of Pisa

Agnellus was born in Pisa in 1195 of the prominent Agnelli family. In 1212, during a visit to Pisa by Saint Francis, he received Agnellus into the Franciscan Order.

Francis sent Agnellus to Paris, where he built a friary and became Guardian. He then returned to Italy, and was present at the "Chapter of Mats." Agnellus was then sent to establish the Order in England.

Insh the Order in England.
On September 10, 1224,
Agnellus and his party of eight
friars, landed at Dover. They
were received by the Benedictine
monks of Fécamp Abbey, who
kindly paid their way. When
they arrived at Canterbury,
they were hospitably received by
the Dominicans, a mendicant
order that had already arrived
in England in 1221 and established a friary in the town. On
the way to Oxford, they found



shelter in a barn belonging to the Benedictines of Abingdon Abbey, who at first thought they were a band of ragged minstrels. At Oxford, King Henry III gave them land on which to build a friary. Agnellus established a school for the friars at Oxford, and asked Robert Grosseteste to serve as lector in theology to the Franciscans, a position he held from about 1229 to 1235. The English Franciscan Order subsequently played a large role in the establishment of the University of Oxford.

Agnellus became known for his humble piety and prudence. In 1234, he was part of a delegation representing the English bishops at the Roman Curia.

By the time of his death, there were forty-three friaries established in the English Province. Agnellus passed away after a brief illness, on May 7, 1236. His remains were buried at Oxford. The Feast day of Saint Agnellus of Pisa is March 13.
