

LAUREN SCALES MIKE FLANAGAN, CHRIS GRASSO -MANY RIVERS (CD)

Truth Revolution Records Looking for great sounds with a local flavor, let me introduce you to Scales, Flanagan & Grasso, a forward-thinking jazz trio defined by dynamic interplay, genre-blending rep-ertoire, and a shared reverence for storytelling through music. Lauren Scales is a Detroitborn vocalist, composer, and multi-instrumentalist whose musical pedigree and versatility span jazz, R&B, and progressive soul. Mike Flanagan is a Billboard-charting, OUTmusic Award-winning, and John Lennon Songwriting Awardwinning saxophonist, pianist, and composer. Chris Grasso is a jazz pianist and music director who built his career in Washington, D.C. before relocating to Provincetown, MA. Vocalist Lauren Scales, saxophonist Mike Flanagan, and pianist Chris Grasso-a hold new jazz trio blending tradition with modern soul — announce the release of their second single, "Play Me" The track marks the second single from their upcoming album Many Rivers, slated for release on August 8, 2025 via Truth Revolution Records Collective. The track also features drummer Charles Haynes and bassist Luques Curtis. Originally featured on D'Angelo's Voodoo — a hallmark of the neosoul movement - the trio's take reimagines the groove-driven track through a straight-ahead jazz aesthetic. With tight interplay, soulful improvisation, and Scales' charismatic vocal delivery, this version straddles homage and invention. "Roy Hargrove's presence on the original made it feel like a bridge into our world," says saxophonist Mike Flanagan. "There's a groove and lyricism that spoke to all of us. Our version lets us honor that while interpreting it through our shared jazz lens." The group came together in Provincetown, MA, where Mike Flanagan, then serving as Entertainment Director for two local venues, brought Scales and Grasso together for a series of shows. The performances quickly gained traction, leading to a summer-long residency and a 6-city U.S. tour in 2023. Along the way, they played celebrated venues such as Scullers Jazz Club, City Winery Boston, The Carlyle Room (D.C.), Green Room 42 (NYC), and The Side Door Jazz Club (CT), eventually headlining Town Hall in

THE BAND OF HEATHENS -LIVE AT ROCKPALAST 2009 (CD) Made in Germany Music

The three front musicians of The Band of Heathens, Colin Brooks, Gordy Quist and Ed Jurdi, all not only excellent singers and instrumentalists, but also very talented songwriters, founded the band in November 2005 in Austin, Texas. Bassist Seth Withney and drummer John Chipman, who had previously played with The Resentments, completed the quintet in 2007. Since then, the Texans have enjoyed a great

reputation among Americana and roots rock fans. The band's first two albums were live CDs and it was only in May 2008 that the five musicians recorded their first studio album, produced by U.S. folk rock leg-end Ray Wylie Hubbard. The album reached number 1 in the Americana Charts and the Euro Americana Charts, In addition, the band won the 'Austin Music Award' as Best New Band. In 2009, the next long-player, 'One Foot in the Ether', followed, and in the fall The Band of Heathens successfully toured Europe, also making a Rockpalast appearance on November 8th at the Harmonie in Bonn. If you like The Band, The Eagles or The Jayhawks, Dan Penn or Jake Smith a/k/a The White Buffalo and have developed an affinity for country meets soul. meets folk and gospel, this Rockpalast is for you and you can enjoy plenty of musical Southern atmosphere.
