The master of jazz fusion drums has put out a record that is one of the genre's elite works.



### Collage *Moonshine*

(1994/Metal Mind)

Obscure in America, this Polish act's best album gets re-born with three bonus cuts.



### David Crosby *If I Could Only Remember My Name*

(1971/Warner Bros.)

Crosby's solo debut includes DVD version in surround sound, lyrics and video footage.



### Def Leppard *Hysteria*

(1987/UME)

The comprehensive Hysteria pack, including all of its B-sides, live tracks and remixes.



### Loverboy *Get Lucky*

(1981/Legacy)

Get "Working for the Weekend" with this arena rock favorite; features four bonus demos.



### Mama's Boys *Power and Passion*

(1985/Gott)

The McManus brothers comprise this long-gone, fist-



### Pavement *Wowee Zowee*

(1995/Matador)

The "Sordid Sentinels Edition" is packed with 50 total tracks and a 64-page booklet.



### Placebo *Placebo*

(1996/EMI)

The underrated Brit-pop premiere combined with a DVD of live performances and videos.



### Porcupine Tree *Stupid Dream*

(1999/Snapper)

This long-awaited reissue offers PT's acclaimed album in 5.1 surround sound.



### Queensryche *Q2K*

(1999/Rhino)

Not deserving of rebirth, this disappointing album boasts four extra songs.

### Lou Reed *Coney Island Baby*

(1976/Legacy)



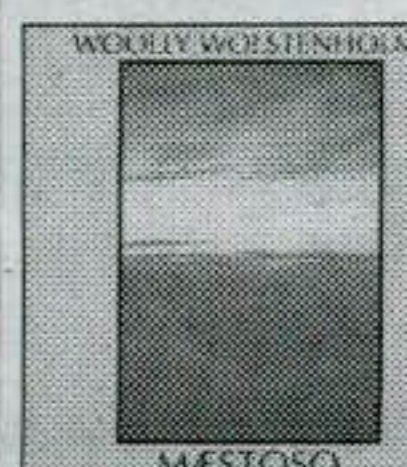
Four years after Transformer, Reed released this artsy gem; contains six bonus tracks.
