Gorgoroth - Black Mass Krakow 2004 (DVD) - added - July 5th, 2008 Reviewer: Ruben Mosqueda



Norwegian black metal band, Gorgoroth's highly controversial 2004 show filmed in Krakow, Poland has seen the light of day via Metal Mind Productions. This is an over the top performance to begin with but they brought a little more to the production by adding severed sheep heads on stakes scattered throughout the stage, satanic propaganda, gallons of sheep blood and what's a party without crucified virgins? This is so over the top that the theatrics take away from the band's performance and become somewhat of a distraction. If you have a weak stomach you'll definitely find this DVD revolting. Gorgoroth came under fire for offending Christians and animal rights folks with their props. The masters of this show were initially seized by Polish officials and the production company was fined by the government. Eventually the tapes were released and now available for the first time worldwide. There's additional footage from the *Full Force Festival* from 2000, as well as the obligatory photo gallery and band bio. *Black Mass Krakow* will thrill black metal fans as for the rest of you it'll be one you'll want to pass on.
