Their genre coverage is vast, they have something for everyone. The company has mushroomed into several divisions in order to accommodate their ever growing catalog.

MVD Entertainment Group, (previously known as Music Video Distributors, Inc.), is a corporation consisting of three major divisions: MVD Visual, MVD Audio, and MVD Distribution.

MVD Visual

MVD's exclusively represented Music DVD division has been re-branded as MVD Visual. Since 1999, this division has released over 500 titles, and is currently one of the largest producers of Music DVD in 2006.

MVD Visual specializes in producing, releasing, marketing, and distributing music-related DVDs for worldwide release. MVD Visual has an unparalleled focus on music DVD, which allows for aggressive marketing, publicity, promotion, and sales. Music DVD is center stage for MVD Visual, not an ancillary project. MVD Visual also includes Eclectic DVD, which features unusual, sometimes cult non-music DVD products.

MVD Audio

MVD Audio handles exclusive distribution and representation for audio content on CD. MVD Audio has content agreements with several record labels including Inakustik (Germany), Secret Records Ltd. (UK), and Metal Mind Productions (Poland) as well as many independent artists.


MVD Distribution

The wholesale operation of MVD is now called MVD Distribution. This division is a one-stop for Music DVD, carrying the best selection of the format in the world, and further offers a very large selection of non-music DVD. MVD Distribution executes the physical fulfillment of its products (including MVD Audio and MVD Visual), servicing major chains, distributors, one-stops, online retail, and independent retail. MVD Distribution runs its 20,000 square foot warehouse in Oaks, PA.

History

MVD was founded in 1986 by Tom Seaman, an industry veteran of more than 40 years, whose background includes retailing stints with Record Hunter, Sam Goody, Musicland, CBS Retail, and wholesale experience with Jem Records. MVD initially acted primarily as a one-stop, buying all labels' music-related VHS releases and reselling to music and video stores. Getting involved with DVD early, MVD called upon its strong relationships with content holders, labels, artists, and management to become a world leader in music DVD. In 2006, MVD expanded further and launched an audio CD division based on these same strong relationships with suppliers and customers.




VELVET UNDERGROUND - UNDER REVIEW

Velvet Underground Under Review is a 75 minute film reviewing the music and career of one of rock music's most influential collectives; a band which esteemed music journalist Lester Bangs claims started modern music. It features rare musical performances never available before as well as obscure footage, rare interviews and private photographs of and with Lou Reed, Andy Warhol, Sterling Morrison and John Cale. The film also features; rarely seen promo films; material from Andy Warhol's private film collection; interviews with colleagues, producers, musicians and friends; TV clips; location shots and a host of other features.




ROLLING STONES - UNDER REVIEW-1962 - 1966




LED ZEPPELIN - ORIGIN OF THE SPECIES

It features rare musical performances, and

obscure footage of rare interviews and rarely seen photographs. The program is injected with review, comment, criticism and insight from; Alan Clayson, former Melody Maker journalist, Chris Welch; ex-1960s NME editor, Keith Altham; Yardbirds guitarist, Chris Dreja; and many more.



TROWER, ROBIN - LIVING OUT OF TIME: LIVE


Description:

This fascinating 13-song performance was recorded by the famous WDR Rockpalast on Robin Trower's 60th birthday, March 9th 2005 at the Crossroads Festival in Germany. Trower's

career has spanned more than four decades and he is considered to be one of the finest guitarists in Rock n' Roll history. He spent the early 60's playing guitar in various London based outfits, and received his big break 1967 joining Procol Harum. After leaving Procol Harum 5 years later, Trower embarked on his solo career and found great success. This DVD displays the fluid and powerful guitar style that has made him legendary.

Description:


Only a few times in history has a musician been singled out as the world-class master of his instrument. Billy Cobham is one of those few artists. For over 30 years, he has received international acclaim
