■ **GREEN APPLE ENTERTAINMENT** Oct. 11 (Sept. 13) shows the seeds of terror with *Farm* (DVD \$24.98). Opening Oct. 25 (prebook Sept. 27) is *19 Doors* (DVD \$24.98), in which a screenwriter is haunted in an abandoned hotel.

■ **IMAGE ENTERTAINMENT** Sept. 6 re-releases Wes Craven's *The Hills Have Eyes* (DVD \$9.98, Blu-ray \$17.97) and, with Lakeshore Entertainment, the Image Madness Series, which includes *Children of the Corn* (DVD \$9.98, Blu-ray \$17.97), *Elvira: Mistress of the Dark* (DVD \$9.98), *Hellraiser* (DVD \$9.98, Blu-ray \$17.97), *Creepshow 2* (DVD \$9.98), *Return of the Killer Tomatoes* (DVD \$9.98) and *Vamp* (DVD \$9.98, Blu-ray \$17.97).
