Thursday of last week would have been Len Barry's 83rd birthday having passed away back on November 5, 2020. I loved that song of his and we used it in the band too. Barry had some other hits too. He started out as a member of The Dovells (1957-63) before going solo with other hits like "You Baby," "Bristol Stomp," and "Keem-O-Sabe," which I always called the Lone Ranger song.

Back on June 6th, the band released a brand-new album called Walk this Road and it is filled with some great new stuff. The older this band gets, the better it gets.
