Film Review: Banshee!!!

Uh, just so you know – adding numerous exclamation marks to the title of your horror movie does not make it more exciting or watchable. Although, considering the juvenile depths to which this film unashamedly plunges, I suppose I should consider myself lucky that it wasn't written in all caps, or perhaps spelled: "B@N\$HEE!!!"

Ugh, I'll try to make this as brief and as painless as humanly possible so you won't have to suffer as I did. Banshee!!! is the story of a bunch of vacuous teens who don't really like each other but decide to go camping in the deep dark woods together anyway. Their trip coincides with the accidental release of a centuries-old monster from the ruins of a wrecked car, recently uncovered by backwoods redneck and possible former WWE wrestler Jack. Oh, and it it ALSO coincides with a visit from Jack's beloved grandson, an aspiring rock star who goes by the lame name of "Rocker".

Anyway, the monster is a banshee, a creature who can emit high frequency sound waves which can either burst your eardrums or make you think it's actually a hot young hitchhiker. Yeah, okay... Anyway, it gets loose, kills off the most dispensable cast members (i.e. the horny young couple and the lone black guy) and corners Jack, Rocker, and semi-pretty Veronica in an isolated cabin. 
