Dwarves' HeWhoCanNotBeNamed Debut Solo Record Coming in June by Howard Wyman

[Via AntiMusic] Ah, the Dwarves. Where would we be without them? Probably the same place we're at now, but with fewer and less gnarly stains on our oldest, rattiest t-shirts, perhaps. At any rate, Dwarves' masked guitarist HeWhoCanNotBeNamed-you know, the one who got the band booted from Sub Pop back in '93 for faking his own death-is goin' solo, as they say, and he's got his debut solo LP coming out this June, entitled Sunday School Massacre.

It's ironic that, after something like a quarter century of making music, he is only now attempting to "make a name for himself." All songs are written by Mr. HeWho, and are performed by the guitarist along with a healthy round-up of other Dwarves-related figures, including Dwarves singer Blag Dahlia, occasional Dwarves/current KMFDM drummer Andy Selway (or Dutch Ovens, as he's known in the Dwarves), and bassist Nick Oliveri, also known for his work with Queens of the Stone Age.
