3For those of us who love good, old American punk rock, the Dwarves are 4probably a household name. If you were able to witness the often shocking, 5sometimes downright disgusting live show they put on, you will most likely

remember their frequently naked, always masked guitarist, HeWhoCanNotBeNamed. In 1993, the band announced that the masked member had been stabbed to death in my own city, Philadelphia. Luckily for all fans, this simply turned out to be a tawdry hoax, as HeWhoCanNotBeNamed is alive and well and has just released his debut solo album "Sunday School Massacre".

As a fan of the Dwarves, I cannot say enough good things about this album. "Sunday School Massacre" stays true to the Dwarves original style, while adding personal touches from the album's creator. Majorly influenced by his time spent as a counselor for mentally ill and abused teens, most of the songs provide a creative twist on real world issues. The songs are catchy, ironic, and heavily guitar-based, and I just can't get enough of them.

The album itself, co-produced by Bradley Cook is excellently put together. Dwarves' fans will be happy to hear some of the collaborations with Blag Dahlia, Andy Selway, and Nick Oliveri. There has been a lot of buzz around the track "Machine Boy", but my favorite by far would have to be "Superhero". I really have no complaints about this album. It is refreshing to listen to something that brings me back to my original favorite music, the sound that made me start going to live shows as a preteen. These days, it is rare to hear a fresh, true-to-form punk rock album, that hasn't been tainted by pop culture (I mean, come on Rancid, "Indestructible"? Really?). Pick up "Sunday School Massacre" and remember why you love punk music. You will not be disappointed.


