The DVD here includes a 23-minute documentary, live performances and music videos, and there are two audio discs filled with music either written or co-written by Manzanera during his time with the band Roxy Music, as a soloist and as a producer for others. Nice collection for fans.

"Eric Sardinas and Big Motor Live" (MVD, 2010, \$14.95). Blues/rock performer Sardinas is captured live in a 45-minute concert that was obviously filmed for television (and includes a brief interview).

"The Year Without Santa Claus" (Warner/Blu-ray, 1974, two discs, \$19.97). The beloved '70s stop-motion animated special gets the high-definition treatment with this release. And the show is still fun, with voices provided by Mickey Rooney, Shirley Booth and Dick Shawn. Also here are "Rudolph's Shiny New Year" and "Nestor the Long-Eared Christmas Donkey."

"Phineas and Ferb: A Very Perry Christmas" (Disney, 2007, \$19.99). This holiday episode of the popular "Phineas and Ferb" cartoon series, which is off-the-wall and filled with pop-culture references, has the title characters joining Perry the Platypus to foil Dr. Doofenshmirtz's plot to ruin Christmas.
