

# Creep Creepersin's Frankenstein (2009) Movie Review

FRANKENSTEIN "HOLY SHIT, FRANKENSTEIN! I HAVE AN IDEA!"

Victor a lonely recluse spends his days watching old movies with his best friend and only companion, his pet rat, he affectionately named FRANKENSTEIN. Haunted by his dead mother, Victor's grasp on reality is blurred and when he starts receiving transmissions from the TV, Victor creates what he so desperately is lacking...a REAL friend.

This is a sad themed movie with a socially inept man living a most dismal life. Even his surroundings show a bleak existence. Victor's only friend is a rat and uses the television as an escape from his boring, lonely life. I felt sorry for Victor all the way through and kept waiting for something exciting to happen. SOMETHING, that would be great or happy for poor Victor (James Porter) but even after his creation is made, it

lacked a certain "oomph" quality. I was bored. There were a few saving factors worth mentioning, seeing the old movies like The Hunchback of Notre Dame and Nosferatu on Victor's television set was cool, but for me, it was the soundtrack that I loved most of all.

The opening overture instrumental music was beautiful in a haunting somber way, setting the mood for the picture. And one of my favorite songs by Creepersin was included in the movie, Yvonne DeCarlo! The sound effects and music are what made me watch this all the way to the end. The rest was just filler. This is not a modern retelling of Frankenstein the monster, but a tale of a lonely man who slips further and further over the edge into madness. Rating: 6/10

### THE RISE OF CREEPERSIN MUSIC REVIEW

New to the sound of the band Creepersin, I asked band leader Creep, how best to describe his music. I thought it had a Rock-a-Billy vibe and Creep said more like a "Psycho-Billy" and I couldn't agree with him more. The band is horror based and the riffs on these songs were heavy and laced with things that go bump in the night, Lycanthropy. Anyone that can sing a song with this word in it and not trip over the pronunciation has my respect!

Horror rock is an anomaly for me and something I would like to change, if all the horror rock bands are like CREEPERSIN, then I want to hear some more! All of the songs had that driving hard edge and pounding of the drums, heavy on bass, a kickass list of horror decadence, if ever I heard. The titles were CREEPTASTIC, (sorry couldn't resist) check them out: Meet Me Out in the Sticks, Bleed for Me, Last House on the Left On Mockingbird Lane, Evil Eye, Dead by Dawn, Lycanthropy, Cleaverland, Proceed with Plan 9, Coffin Drop, Get Off My Knife, Vasaria Visaria, The Hills Have Eyes and To Dance with the Dead. Hard not to find one that I didn't like, as matter of fact, I can't ... I love them all!

If you are in the mood, to piss someone off, pop THE RISE OF CREEPERSIN in the CD player and turn that MOTHER UP! If you live in Louisiana or any other state with lots of bridges...LONG bridges, this CD is perfect bridge music. I shelf my books at the bookstore rocking out with CREEPERSIN! Would I recommend this CD...HELL YEAH! I WOULD and DO! On the back of the CD it has CREEP CREEPERSIN AND "THE BAND THAT TERRORIZED THE WORLD", I don't know about that, but they sure as hell ROCK MINE!






