THE TRIPLE THREAT CD is my first taste of DIE MONSTER DIE and I am happy to say not the last time I will listen to them. A cool tidbit the bands' is a reference to a 1965 Boris Karloff movie based on a H.P. Lovecraft story. Their first song on the CD, A PRIEST AND A ZOMBIE RENT A FISHING BOAT AS FRIENDS is my favorite by this Salt Lake City band. Guilty for not knowing squat about the band, all I have learned, comes from the Internet.

Their songs have catchy titles that are hard to forget once you listen they seep into your head and attach themselves to our brain and won't let go! Check out the titles: A PRIEST AND A ZOMBIE RENT A FISHING BOAT AS FRIENDS, ALL COVERED IN BLOOD, AND DRESSED LIKE A WHORE, DEEP SPACE ISOLATION PSYCHOSIS, LUCKY NUMBER 666 (2ND Fave from DMD) and WORLD NEEDS MONSTERS.

I am not an authority on punk or horror metal, gothic, but I know what I like and having recently discovered Creepersin, I can safely say, these bands are new favorites that I would like to listen to more of in the future. The common thread they share is dark, edgy and deeply moody. The guitar pacing is fast and the bass furious with attitude and the pounding the skins take from these three bands is heavy and aggressive. I can feel and hear the testosterone coming loud and clear through my headset. Their passion for their music reverberates and bounces off my walls when cranked up as it has been of late.
