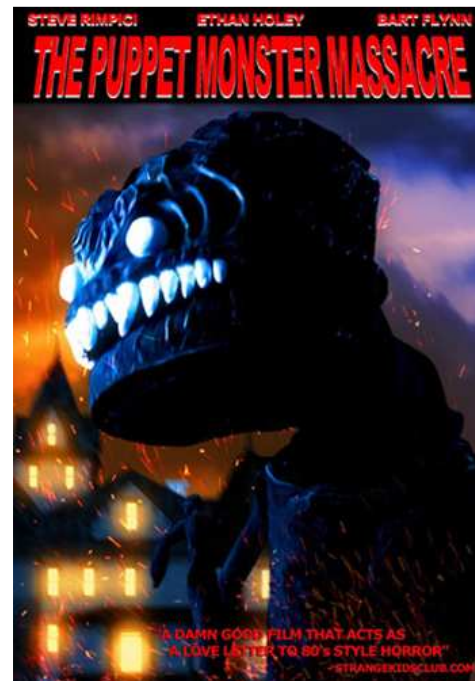




Film Review: The Puppet Monster Massacre (2010)

You know The Black Saint keeps an open mind to all manner of films that I review. Before I make any assumptions before I see a movie, I take every movie at face value until I see it. When I saw "The Puppet Monster Massacre", I told myself "Self, It's about a bunch of foul mouthed

The plot of "PMM" reminded me a lot of "Mad Monster Party" and "House On Haunted Hill" (the movie even mentions "House On Haunted Hill" in the movie). Five people are sent a letter inviting them to a dreaded Wagner mansion. If any one of them can make it through the evening they win the cash, and forfeit the cash. The five chosen are Charlie (The "Hero"), Gwen (The tell her), Raimi (The movie geek who's never had a woman), Iggy (The defiant puppeteer), and a whorish lady friend). All of them arrive at the same time to the mansion except for Charlie who is outside the mansion for a few hours since he really didn't have much to do.



And who greets them? It's Dr. Wolfgang Wagner! An evil scientist who was respected, but he doesn't plan on letting anyone survive the evening. Why does he want to kill them? Why does he have a torture room full of cute little bunnies? Well the heck is a penguin walking around killing people all about? Well all of the answers are in the movie & I think you're missing a pretty good little movie if you don't see it.

The script is fairly simple & it's (Mostly) very funny as well. Some of the jokes fall a little flat but by and large it's a pretty funny script & I laughed out loud a lot more than I expected. The voice performances are pretty funny as well but special mention has to be given to Raimi's performance as Raimi (A nod to director Sam Raimi). It's a perfect geeky voice to listen to.
