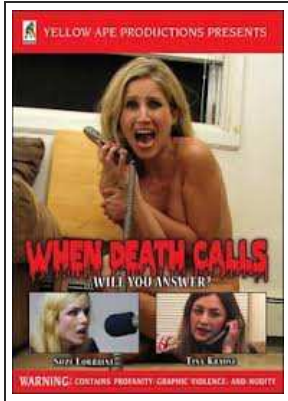




DVD REVIEW: WHEN DEATH CALLS

WHEN DEATH CALLS is a new [indie horror](#) anthology from writer-director **Jim Haggerty**. A flick that pays homage to those crazy [B-movies](#) from the 70's and early 80's. The movie takes place on Halloween as we watch (or listen) to DJ Roxy Richards ask her listeners to call in and [share](#) their scary stories. The stories all vary, from [monsters](#) in [the basement](#) to stalkers preying on their potential victims, to cheating spouses and more which all lead to the movie's pretty cool ending.

Like I stated, the movie is an anthology and it is as micro budget and indie as it gets. The stories are pretty simple but what makes them fun is the fact that we get plenty of blood and boobs and then more boobs and personally I don't have a problem with that at all folks! Each segment in the anthology is stand alone and it's the wrap around with DJ Roxy that ties them all together. The only thing with this wrap around is the fact that it reminded me of a few other movies where the DJ took the [calls](#) and then some creepy things began to happen.

Suzi Lorraine, **Tina Krause** and **Nathalie Bryant** all appear in the movie. It's always good [watching](#) Suzi Lorraine in anything and honestly the world needs more Lorraine! After viewing this movie I think I've become a fan of Bryant's as well. These aren't the only females in the movie but they are the standouts to me!

Haggerty did a great [job](#) with his camera and the crisp [picture](#) as well as the sound. There's still a lot of [indie movies](#) that still struggle with these two problems but *When Death Calls* passes with flying colors when it comes to these two obstacles. The music added in also mixes in well and that's also a plus. To me, Haggerty is a pretty cool storyteller and who knows what he could do with a movie that actually had a big budget!

Bottom line is, *When Death Calls* was a pretty fun watch. This kind of movie isn't for all horror fans out there but movie buffs like me who [enjoy](#) low budget indie films with a lot of heart will appreciate it. Haggerty knows what the fans like, he kept it simple and added lots of blood and some nudity to the mix that made this movie work. 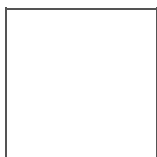

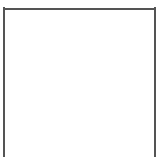

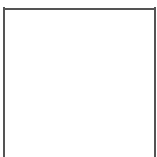
