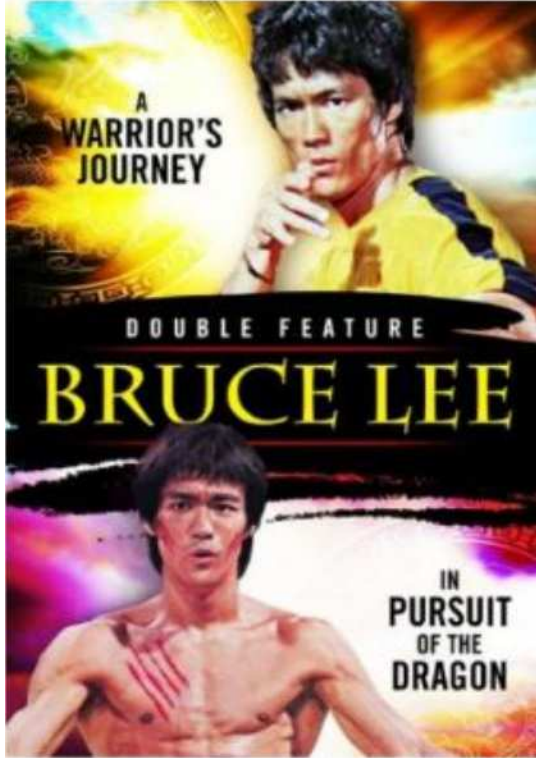

Or something like that. Bruce Lee completists will snap this one right up. It's not a pair of Bruce Lee kung fu fist in yer face flicks but rather a pair of documentaries about the legendary martial artist and film star. The man helped change the face of martial arts cinema and helped widen its audience considerably in the process, so it's no surprise to see not just one but two docs popping up here. Hell, I imagine there's plenty. This BRUCE LEE DOUBLE FEATURE boasts as its duo of docs A WARRIOR'S JOURNEY, which is a loving look at the man shot by a diehard fan, John Little, and IN PURSUIT OF THE DRAGON, which checks out famous locations from Bruce Lee shoots. Both of these documentaries have special surprises. A WARRIOR'S JOURNEY, besides being an affectionate homage to a great athlete and entertainer, is also a source of scenes for those fascinated by Lee's last, and famously unfinished, film, "The Game of Death." The biographical portion of the doc mingles interviews and behind the scenes stuff with highlights of Lee action footage. Then there's the treat, a half hour of nonstop footage from the never completed "The Game of Death." It's a no brainer for Lee fanatics - you gotta see this. IN PURSUIT OF THE DRAGON takes us from our armchairs and sofas to the locations of famous scenes from Lee films - namely a sort of big four, "Fist of Fury," "Enter the Dragon," "The Way of the Dragon" and "The Big Boss." And it's not just a travelogue. Thoughtful editing and documentary narrative approach is employed by the juxtaposition of shots of what the locations looked like back then, and what they look like now. It's a fun contrast and this surely stands as a solid second feature in a double bill of nonfic fan fare for the mighty Bruce Lee.
