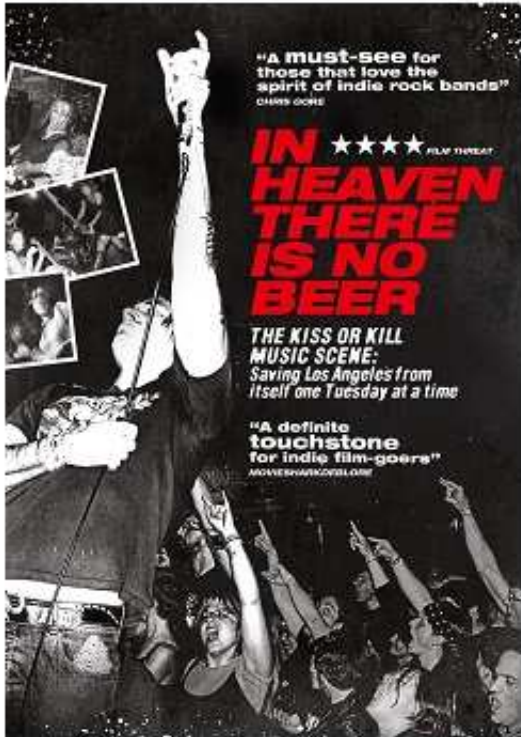


In Heaven There is No Beer

- Insider documentary about the Los Angeles Kiss or Kill music scene (2002-2007).
- Fed up with the Sunset Strip pay-for-play policies, “too cool for school” trendiness of the Silverlake scene and apathetic crowds, the bands that made up Kiss or Kill forged their own scene based on great music, cheap booze, low cover and friendship.

What We Thought:

- **In Heaven There is No Beer** is a documentary about the Kiss or Kill DIY rock scene in LA from 2002 to 2007.
- It's told through all the bands, promoters and fans who were there through the entire scene.
- I guarantee you've probably never heard of most of these bands if any. I lived in LA through some of this time period and even went to Zen Sushi to see a band I knew play there and I've never heard of Kiss or Kill or any of these bands.
- I can't say I became a fan of the bands from hearing what I heard, but it's still a quality rock doc.
- I think it's funny, just like every other scene or a scene of “indie” bands, once one gets some recognition, the others get jealous of why they aren't and things collapse. The woman who helped come up with Kiss or Kill (and is in Bang Sugar Bang) came across as the most jealous because The Dollyrots signed first and then her drummer quit and she wouldn't let him in the club. As much as you think you're a family, your band/project always comes first.
- Even though I didn't know any of the bands in **In Heaven There is No Beer**, it's still a well made

documentary that fans of these bands or this scene will definitely enjoy. Even if you aren't familiar with it, but like music, rock music specifically, you should like it.
