In fact, as this documentary explains, the Freestyle is at the very heart of hip-hop, whether it is how the DJ reacts to a crowd or how a b-boy reacts to the beats with his body. While these ideas are explored in this 75-minute feature, the real focus is, of course, with the MC.

Including interviews and freestyle footage of names from across the United States, this film shows rappers such as The Freestyle Fellowship, Craig G, Mos Def, Pharoahe Monch, Supernatural, Chicago's Juice, and more as it unlocks the science

behind freestyle hip-hop. Whether it is the MC battle or the cypher, this documentary goes straight to the heart of the matter.


'Freestyle: The Art of Rhyme' also takes time to question why there seems to be a disparity between freestyle skills and record sales, as well as marking the difference between a written and a freestyle rhyme.

Still holding weight some ten years after it was originally released, this documentary is necessary viewing for aspiring MCs, established rappers, and those with a love of hip-hop music and culture. Packed with rare and archive footage, this documentary remains the definitive look at the art of off-the-head rhyming.

Check this, and you will most-likely find yourself trying to drop some rhymes in homage to the art. Still getting it done in 2014, 'Freestyle: The Art of Rhyme' demands attention.
