LUST FOR LIFE Lana Del Rey

SAXOPHONE COLOSSUS

Documentary filmmaker Robert Mugge has crafted a brilliant portrait of jazz master on the saxophone, Sonny Rollins. The film is centered on Rollins' first orchestral piece which would premiere in Tokyo, Japan. Not only is there a look at the action behind-thescenes and of this concert, Mugge includes interviews extolling Rollins' talent and musical gifts while also conducting an interview with Sonny and his wife Lucille (who died in 2004). Fitzgibbon heads The Irish Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals. A poignant look at righting the wrongs to the animals who deserve a safe and caring place. **Available August 22.**
