reviews: Kip Winger "From the Moon to the Sun"

A friend of mine once described an artist to me as simply good music. Genre was irrelevant. The same could be said of Kip Winger. He's simply a fantastic songwriter. He falls readily into no pre-fab category. From soft, ballady material to exuberant songs that wouldn't be out of place in a rock-based musical, from opinionated and melodic anthems to boistrous pop. Winger also incorporates world music elements into some of his music. He has a certain theatrical flair - without becoming flamboyant. His music - especially instrumental tracks like "Ghost" - suggest a film score influence to his style, as well. It says something for Winger that "From the Moon to the Sun" is eelectic while suggesting prog/concept album inclinations - but never abandoning accessibilty to a broad range of listeners.
