As the lucrative holiday season approaches, many gift-worthy reissue and archival releases are starting to be announced. Ween revealed the details of <u>At The Cat's Cradle, 1992</u>, the band's first live album from the days when Gene and Dean toured the country accompanied by only a DAT machine. This full show CD and bonus DVD will be available on November 11.
