

Cover the Earth is, as the title implies, a collection of 24 covers ranging from obvious stuff you'd expect from Tesco and his men of meat (G.G. Allin, Fear, Johnny Thunders, Motorhead, etc.) to some stuff that might surprise you (10CC, The Temptations, Jerry Lee Lewis, etc.). No surprise that Cover the Earth is terrific because for all of Tesco's slapstick jokeyness he is a music fan first and foremost (and is the world's biggest Abba fan, who they cover here with a rousing rendition of "So Long"). If you want to hear some high-octane, grunting scorch check out the version of Blue Oyster Cult's "Me 262" or Saxon's "Freeway Mad" and, of course, Fear's "I Love Living in the City." Funny, too, as I always thought what The Meatmen were doing was far superior to similar jokesters like Fear.
