After an introduction by Joey Ramone, Batars hits the stage prancing around in a shiny black PVC get-up that brings to mind Freddie Mercury's outfits in Queen's *Jazz/The Game* period. The first song is their trademark anthem, "Sonic Reducer," which they evidently like so much they perform it twice. Ironically, the highlight isn't one of their own songs, but a sizzling cover of the Stooges' "Search and Destroy," a clear testament to their allegiance to the spirit of rock 'n' roll. Unfortunately, the camera work is very basic, filmed from the back of the hall, with occasional zooms.
