

Buy T.S.O.L. The Early Years Live on DVD

Formed in Long Beach, California, T.S.O.L. (or "True Sounds of Liberty") recorded one of my favorite punk songs, "Code Blue," which is also one of the funniest songs, ever, in any genre. This new DVD, from MVD Visual, showcases two early shows, one 43-minute, outdoor show and an 8-minute indoor show (from the Target Video vaults). Watching outdoor punk shows in broad daylight seems almost beside the point. The footage and audio is strictly amateur hour, and the crowd at the longer show doesn't even appear to know which band they're watching (they start out sitting politely on the grass). Moreover, the track listing on the DVD is wrong. When I punched in "Abolish"
