I cannot, for the life of me, make heads or tails out of Bill (**Flesh Gordon, Mona**) Osco's **Urban Legends** (**MVD**). The box cover art sells this as a horror anthology of sorts, but what's really inside is a haphazard collection of gore shorts and terrible gag commercials (many featuring The Unknown Comic, who was in Osco's **Night Patrol**), all highlighted by nails-on-a-chalkboard commentary by retro-lounge singer Dino Lee in a huge bouffant wig as Rusty DeFage. If Lee's verbal diarrhea doesn't send you screaming for the exits, the amateur quality of the shorts – many of which feature Carl Crew of *Dahmer* fame in Divine-style drag – may try even the highest tolerance for no-budget splatter. The DVD includes a short B&W Super-8 film called **The Art of Nude Bowling**, which features several ladies – one of whom could be charitably described as morbidly obese – tossing strikes in their birthday suits while Lee chatters incessantly on the soundtrack. I'm an Osco fan to the core, but *caveat emptor*, sleaze beasts.
