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Snoop Dogg: Drop It Like It's Hot" (MVD Visual DVD, NR, 85 min.). For those into rap, Snoop Dogg is one of the premiere entertainers and this disc captures a Feb. 23, 2005 show in Bruxelles (Brussels), with special guest The Game. Snoop's 1993 album "Doggystyle" became the first debut album to enter the charts at number one, where it stayed for several weeks. This show includes his hits "What's My Game?" (recently performed on the soap opera "One Life To Love") and "Gin & Juice," as well as the more recent title song and "Get Blown." The 19 selections also include "Da Boss Would Like To See You," "Murder Was the Case," "The Shaznit," "The Bidness" and "P.I.M.P." Bonuses include an in-depth look at Snoop over the years, a before-the-concert segment and two tracks, "Wrong Idea" and "Deep Cover," from Jamaica's Reggae Sunfest in 2001, when Snoop was charged with using profane language. Finally, there is a biography, discography and flexography in the 20-page booklet. **Grade: A-**
