CHIC — LIVE AT THE BUDOKAN (DVD) Charly-MVDvisual

Between 1977 and 1980, Chic produced some of the most successful and memorable music of the disco era. Chic is the group's final performance April 1996 at Tokyo's famous Budokan Stadium. They perform their mega-hit single "Le Freak" with Guns 'n' Roses guitarist Slash soloing, on the hit that went on to sell four million copies. Also joining Chic is Sister Sledge delivering their two biggest hits, "He's The Greatest Dancer" and "We Are Family," both written and produced by Chic's legendary writer/producers, Nile Rodgers and Bernard Edwards. Sadly. Edwards died shortly following this concert which featured extended versions of "Dance, Dance, Dance," "I Want Your Love" and "Good Times." (1 hr. 23 mins.).
