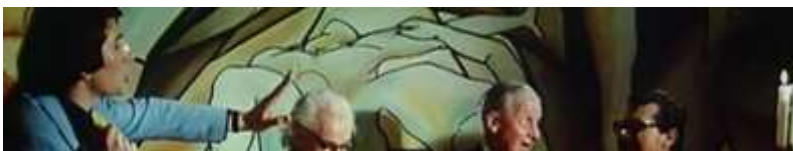

Pallardy (*Truck Stop*, *My Body Burns*). He also directed the film as Jean-Mark the son of the Noble Prostitute colony in the film. The screenplay for *Erotic Diary of a Lumberjack* was co-written by Sophie Verdaud. This appears to be the first screenplay by the screenwriter. The score for *Erotic Diary of a Lumberjack* is by Eddie Warner who also composed the score for other of Pallardy's films including, *Gunfight at OK Corral*, *Datelines* and *Truck Stop*.

Even though the plot for this film is straightforward, the premise of having a Noble Prostitute colony of drags along. The premise of having a Noble Prostitute colony

essentially a pimp is an interesting one. Unfortunately the end results fall to live up to the film's promising premise. *"Erotic Diary of a Lumberjack"*. The sex scenes are crudely assembled pieces of erotica that lack any sizzle. The only lasting impact is a scene where four men chase two women who they then proceed to rape. Willeke van Ammelrooy, one of the women being victimized, does a good job conveying the anguish her character is going through. The film does feature a few recognizable faces Joëlle Coeur and Marie-Pierre Castel. Both actresses have appeared in other films by Jean Rollin.

The DVD:

Erotic Diary of a Lumberjack is presented in a 1.66:1 letterboxed widescreen. The source materials used for this transfer are in better shape than the ones used for *Truck Stop*. While details are generally crisp, colors tend to fluctuate and flesh tones fare well. This transfer has been flagged for progressive playback.

This release comes with one audio option a Dolby Digital mono mix in English. There is noticeable background noise that varies in degree and there are some issues with distortion. Overall despite these flaws dialog is easy enough to follow.

The bulk of the extras included for this release are also included on Le Chat Qui Fum's DVD's for *Truck Stop* and *My Body Burns*. These extras are as follows trailers for *My Body Burns* (2 minute 7 seconds – in French no English subtitles), *Lucky Lucky & The Datelines* (1 minute 40 seconds – in French no English subtitles), *Gunfight at OK Corral* (1 minute 38 seconds – in French no English subtitles), *a Lumberjack* (1 minute 9 seconds – in French no English subtitles) and *Truck Stop* (1 minute 39 seconds – in French no English subtitles). All five trailers are presented in a letterboxed widescreen. Other extras include an extensive image gallery featurette (12 minutes 48 seconds). The main extra included with this release is a sixty one minute interview with Jean-Marie Pallardy in French with English subtitles. This interview gives a well rounded overview of his career as a filmmaker. Exclusive to this DVD are three deleted / extended sex scenes from the French version of the film (11 minutes letterboxed widescreen).



According to the text on the back of DVD, the director Jean-Marie Pallardy supplied the source materials used in the audio / video presentation could be attributed to that is most likely no better surviving elements for this disappointing part of this release is that the original French language audio with English subtitles was not included. *of a Lumberjack* gets a well rounded DVD release from Le Chat Qui Fum.
