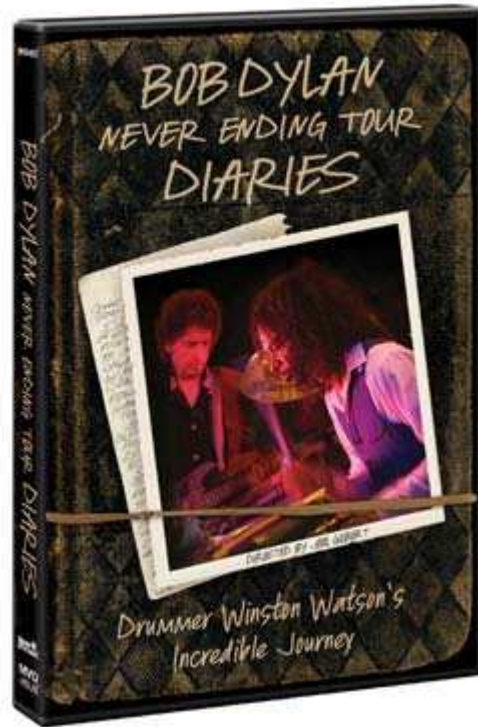

Were there any 'pearls of wisdom' that Bob laid on Winston?

What was it like to be away from his family for such an extended time?

How did Dylan react when Winston Watson was asked to join the Lenny Kravitz band?

Winston was there in October 1992 at The 30th Anniversary Concert at Madison Square Garden. Neil Young, Tom Petty, and George Harrison were all there and appear on the home video Winston shot. Along the way, Jerry Garcia took a liking to Winston when the Dead and Dylan shared some tour dates, which led Grateful Dead roadie Ramrod to wonder why they bonded so well.

In addition to playing all over the United States, Winston traveled to such countries as England, Israel, and Czech Republic on the Never Ending Tour with Dylan. It is rare to gain such insight into the man known as Bob Dylan, but for as much as Winston got to know the man, he comes away still puzzled by the enigma that is and remains Bob Dylan. This DVD is well worth seeking out and should be of interest to all music lovers.
