**What men are these? Men of action, say D.O.A.**

**What men are these? Men of action, say D.O.A.**

Dogged and indefatigable punk rock grandpas D.O.A. still have a lot left to show the young'uns about being hardcore in this country of ours, and to that end they've come up with a publicly available teaching tool: *The Men of Action* 30th Anniversary DVD, assembling classic footage from the band's three-decade career and much more (though don't go running it down yet - it doesn't become available until Aug. 11).

The DVD component of the package is comprised of 26 tunes (10 videos and 16 live tracks), and you can watch them either of two ways: the "Chaos Program" features the videos and performances straight up, while the "Anarchy Program" has D.O.A. lead singer Joey "Shithead" Keithley "telling the story of D.O.A. and punk in general" over top.

And the band has a rather attractive gift for you as well (and we're not talking about the 12-page booklet of rare band photos, though that's cool too). When you buy the DVD, you also get a copy of D.O.A.'s newest, Bob Rock-produced album, *Northern Avenger*. (The first single/video from *Northern Avenger* has just been released, *Police Brutality*, about the RCMP tasing death of Polish immigrant Robert Dziekanski in Vancouver Airport).

D.O.A. are on tour in Europe and the U.S. throughout much of the remainder of July and August, but will join up with fellow Canuck-punk legends SNFU at the Commodore Ballroom in Vancouver on Sept. 26. Definitely not to be missed.
